Modes of Operation

- One device—Tracker + iPhone + Holder
- Two devices—Tracker + iPhone
- Standalone—Tracker only (limited functionality)



If using the tracker with the iPhone, download the GMPT-401 Application from the Apple[®] App Store[®].


iPhone Volume iPhone Front View iPhone Whone Personal Tracker iPhone Power Button iPhone Home Button



Inserting/Removing the Tracker

To insert the tracker in the holder, slide it in the back of the holder until it is secured with a click.


To remove the tracker from the holder, press the release buttons at the same time on each side of the holder and slide the tracker upward.



Inserting/Removing the iPhone

To insert the iPhone:

1. Press the button on the end cap and slide the lock to open.



- 2. Slide iPhone into the holder as shown above.
- 3. Close the end cap and slide the lock until it clicks.


To remove the iPhone:

- 1. Press the button on the end cap and slide the lock to open.
- 2. Slide the iPhone upwards out of the holder.
- 3. Close and lock end cap.

Charging

The tracker can be charged alone or in the holder using the USB cable connected to a wall adapter, PC, portable USB charger, or car charger.

Note: If you use the wall adapter with the tracker and the iPhone in the holder, both will charge.




Status Indicators

Status information is shown in two ways:

- On the iPhone in the GMPT-401 app
- · On the tracker using the LED indicators

On the iPhone

Status indicators are shown on the iPhone when the tracker is connected by Bluetooth to the iPhone and you are using the GMPT-401 app.



Note: The Satellite Coverage indicator shows the last recorded signal strength.

For more detailed status information, touch **Settings** on the bottom of the screen in the GMPT-401 app and select **Status**.

On the Tracker

Network LED

| Color | Indication |
|------------------------|---|
| Green—Flashing | Sending a message and satellite coverage available. |
| Amber—Flashing | No satellite coverage. |
| Green—On for 3 seconds | Message sent successfully. |
| Amber—On for 3 seconds | Sending message failed. |
| Red—Flashing fast | Alert mode is activated, sending SOS message. |
| Red—On for 60 seconds | Emergency message successfully sent. |
| Red—Flashing slowly | System fault. |

Battery LED


| Color | Indication |
|------------------------|------------------------------------|
| Green—On for 2 seconds | Power up. |
| Red—On for 2 seconds | Power down. |
| Green—Flashing slowly | Power on, battery 60-100% charged. |
| Amber—Flashing slowly | Power on, battery 20-60% charged. |
| Red—Flashing slowly | Power on, battery 0-20% charged. |

| Blue—Flashing | In Bluetooth pairing mode (2 min). |

| Blue—On for 3 seconds | Bluetooth paired successfully. |
| Green—Flashing (charging) | Tracker is on, battery is fully charged. |
| Amber—Flashing (charging) | Tracker is on, battery is charging. |
| Green—On (charging) | Tracker is off, battery is fully charged. |
| Amber—On (charging) | Tracker is off, battery is charging. |
| Red, Green, Blue— Flashing sequence | Tracker is in firmware upgrade mode. |

Tracker Registration

Before using the tracker, the unit must have valid airtime and be registered in ViewPoint (or other tracking application). For more information see the ViewPoint User Guide.

Powering the Tracker



To turn the tracker on:

• Press and hold the power button for 2 seconds. The Battery LED is green for 2 seconds, then it flashes to show battery status (see the Battery LED table).

To turn the tracker off:

• Press and hold the power button for 2 seconds. The Battery LED is red for 2 seconds. If paired to a phone, you must confirm you want to turn the tracker off in the GMPT-401 app (configurable see the user documentation).

Bluetooth Connection

To establish a Bluetooth connection between the tracker and your Apple device:

- 1. Turn the tracker on (see above).
- 2. Press and hold the Bluetooth button for 2 seconds on the tracker. The tracker is then discoverable for 2 minutes.



Bluetooth Pairing Button

- 3. Activate Bluetooth on your iPhone
- 4. Open the GMPT-401 app. Touch Settings, Bluetooth. Select the tracker on the list of available devices (see the label on the tracker for the MAC address).
- 5. Enter PIN code 123456. The tracker pairs with the iPhone. When connected the Bluetooth connection icon shows on the status bar of the GMPT-401 app.

Note: The tracker should only be paired with the phone through the GMPT-401 app. Do not pair the tracker via the Bluetooth settings on the phone.

Using the GMPT-401 App

Download the GMPT-401 app from the App Store.


Sending/Receiving Messages

You can send and receive messages without cell phone coverage using the GMPT-401 application. Messages can be sent and received from the following:

- ViewPoint (the online tracking system)
- Another tracker

Pre-set message can be configured and stored in Favorites so that you can send messages quickly and easily.

Contacts

The GMPT-401 app integrates the contacts from your iPhone. To create a new contact, create a contact on the iPhone.

Sending an SOS Message











To send an SOS message from the GMPT-401 app:

- 1. Touch **SOS** at the bottom of the screen.
- 2. Confirm by touching **Send**.

The application indicates that the message has been successfully sent in the message window. You can use the interactive SOS window to send text messages to the monitoring system.

To send an SOS message from the tracker, press and hold the SOS button on the top of the tracker for 2 seconds.

If connected to the iPhone you must confirm this action on the screen of the iPhone before the message is sent (configurable see the user documentation).



Settinas

The **Settings** menu is used to configure the tracker and how it works with the iPhone. You can also access the Status screen for detailed status information.

For more information on configuring your device, see the GMPT-401 Personal Tracker User Guide.

Note: If you are using the tracker in standalone operation, reporting rates and wakeup intervals are configured using the ViewPoint web application or custom application (API).
